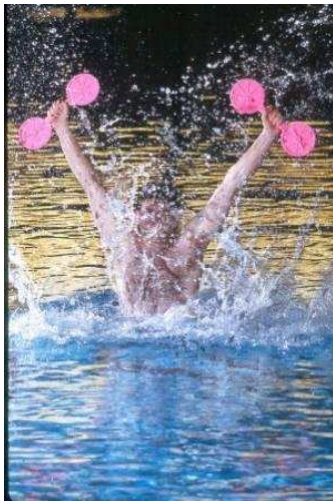




HYDROTHERAPY FOR CHRONIC DISEASE
